The **Consorzio Tutela Vini Delle Venezie DOC** was established in 2017 by the Italian wineries of the North-Eastern territory to create the most prominent wine organization among regions, including, in one big Appellation of Origin, the Autonomous **Region of Friuli-Venezia Giulia**, the Autonomous Province of **Trento** and the **Veneto** region.

The Consortium was founded to protect and promote an Appellation that represents the unique style of the **Italian Pinot Grigio**, well-expressed in the Triveneto area, that produces versatile, fresh and fruity white wines appreciated worldwide. At the end of the entire production chain certification process, each Delle Venezie DOC bottle passes through professional oenologists' tasting commissions and finally receives the Italian Government Seal as the maximum expression of a **certified quality wine**. Moreover, thanks to the recent foundation of the Delle Venezie DOC, **yields per hectare have been reduced** to ensure a new level of qualitative excellence for this great Italian wine.

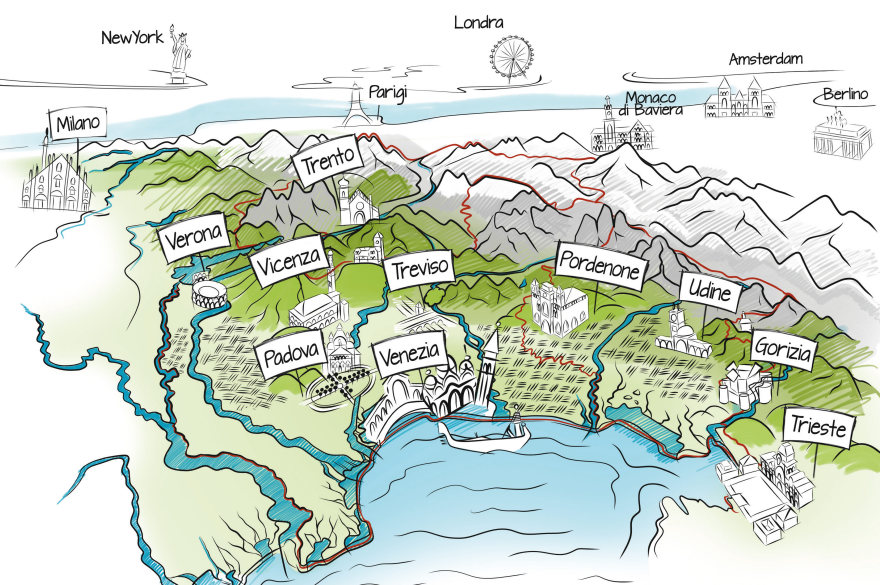

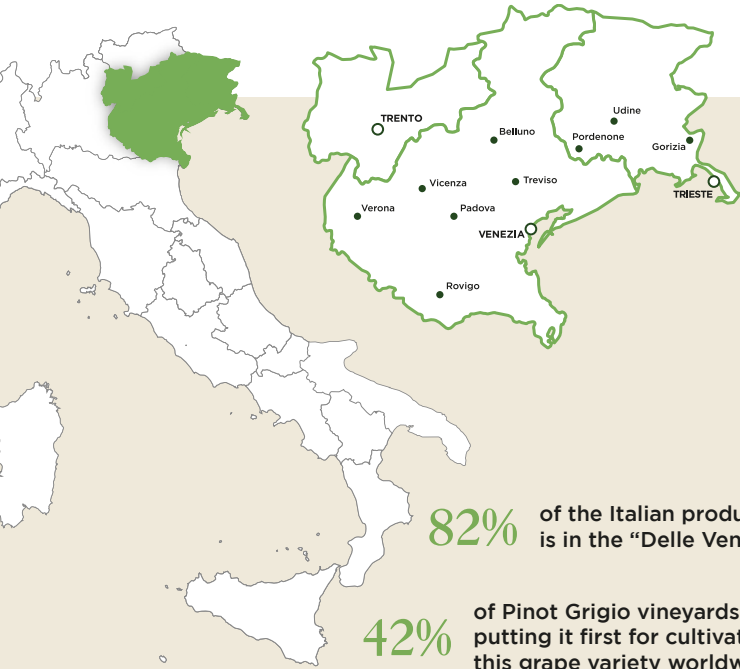

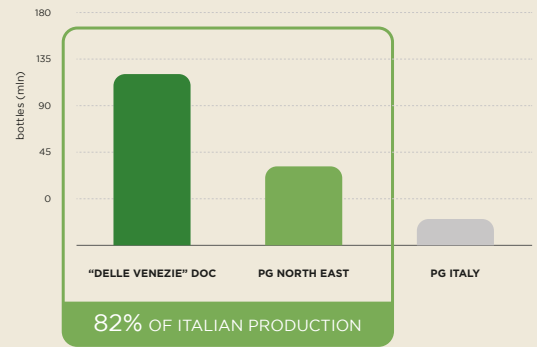
